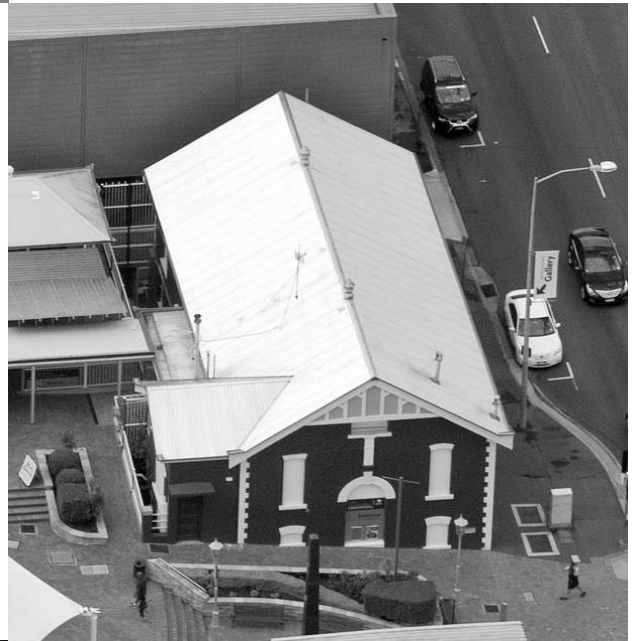

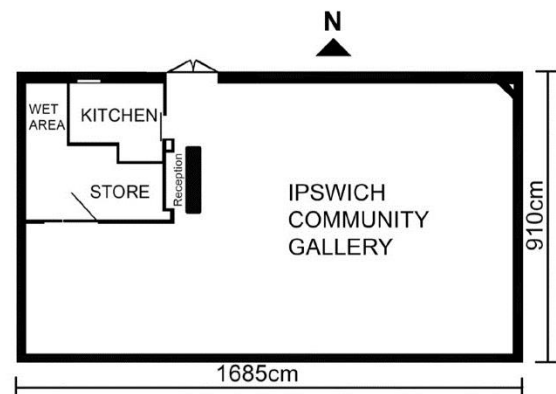
Ipswich Community Gallery

The Ipswich Community Gallery is a Council-owned venue for use by local artists, arts groups, seniors, specialist groups, people with disabilities, school children, youth and other individuals or groups with exhibitions of interest to the Ipswich community. The primary aim of the Ipswich Community Gallery is to support arts and cultural activities in Ipswich. Activities may include exhibitions, displays and associated workshops or cultural events. Exhibition works may be offered for sale. Amateurs or professionals are welcome to apply for use of the Ipswich Community Gallery.

Specifications and dimensions:

The Ipswich Community Gallery is equipped with a track hanging system, basic exhibition lighting and vinyl floor. The Gallery has a lockable storage area containing exhibition plinths, plastic stacking chairs and fold-out tables. In addition there is a kitchenette with fridge and tea/ coffee making facilities. A lectern is available for use at opening events.

Floor Space:	120 square metres
Floor Loading:	250kg per square metre
Hanging Wall Space:	40 running metres
Hanging Track Height:	2.5 metres
Ceiling:	Exposed beams approx 3 metres high with the exposed roof apex at approx 7m high
Entry Door:	2.4m high x 1.5m wide

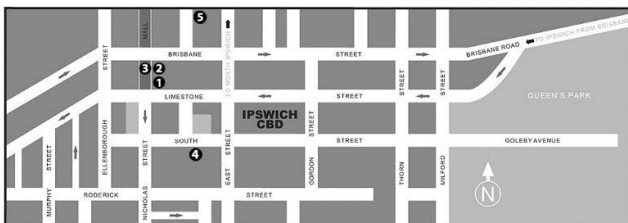


Cost:

A hire fee is payable for use of the venue. Hire fees cannot be waived under any circumstances. The minimum booking period is one (1) week with a maximum booking period of four (4) weeks (including installation and demount time). The hire fee is \$110.00 (including GST) per week. The Ipswich Community Gallery does not take any commission from the sale of works. This cost is valid from 1 July 2016 – 30 June 2017 in accordance with Council's Fees and Charges 2016-2017.
